- Give a class plenty of chance to listen.
- Lots of questions.
- Make questions easy to harder.
- Know who to ask what.
- Ask, then nominate or nominate, then ask.
- One right answer may mean only one person can.
- Involve as many as possible.
- Distribute questions in unpredictable way (also ask those who do not have their hand up).
- Ask the kind of questions you want them to use.
- Give them to ask questions.
- Give them points if they use linking words and specific vocabulary.
